Each year, the annual report gives us an opportunity to reflect on our successes and the moments that challenged us over the past year.

This year, CCX Media shined by providing truly unique programming to residents of the northwest suburbs that is both enriching and award-winning. Our stories are available via cable television, streaming apps like Roku and Amazon Prime, our website and social media, all with no paywalls.

During big election years like 2024, CCX Media takes on the role of a traffic conductor, directing voters to aggregated candidate information so they can be informed at the polls. We worked with the League of Women Voters to facilitate and disseminate forums, and we also provided candidates the opportunity to record their own message. Finally, we streamed local results live on election night and published stories on local races.

The content that we create matters, but the advocacy that we do matters too. We facilitate phone calls weekly from cable customers asking for help on a variety of issues related to their cable subscription. We have worked with our franchise partners to meet consumers' needs and help solve problems.

As viewers' habits change and people cut the cord on cable television, CCX Media has worked legislatively to promote measures that would help provide meaningful revenue and protect community television. We also shared our voice at the state legislature to talk about the work we do in promoting government transparency and truly local programming, protecting public rights-of-way, and touting our consumer advocacy efforts.

Our work is not done! As we head into 2025, we are resolved to continue serving our communities with honesty, professionalism, and integrity while adapting to the ever-changing media landscape.

CONSUMER ADVOCACY

As the Cable Commission, staff field calls from Comcast customers in our nine-city area and then work with customer relations to advocate for consumers. **77** complaints were submitted in 2024.

Complaints range from exposed cable lines across driveways to disconnecting internet, from stopping charges on a deceased spouse's account to not being able to reach a live agent. One customer who called commented,

"You filed a report with my concerns with Comcast Xfinity and I'm calling to say thank you because they got right to work on it... You guys got the ball rolling right away and I am so grateful."

Local non-partisan election information to educate voters



CANDIDATE STATEMENTS

CCX Media provided each candidate on the ballot the opportunity to record a 45-second candidate statement. Voters could access the statements free of charge on YouTube and on our website, ccxmedia.org.

77 candidates recorded statements with an **86** percent participation rate.

CANDIDATE FORUMS

CCX Media collaborated with local chapters from the League of Women Voters to record and disseminate forums featuring local candidates. People could access forums by watching CCX Media channels through cable television or online.

CCX Cities crews recorded and published **22** forums covering **43** races spread out over **18** dates.



CCX Media streamed live local election results straight from the Secretary of State to our channel and website. News crews reported on results and tracked down candidates for Election Night interviews.

News staff covered **39** local elections or levy referendums with **21** published stories and **a dozen** on-camera interviews.

CITIES STORIES

Staff produced and published nearly 300 promotional and informational stories on channels and social media for our nine member cities. Staff also worked to improve turnaround time to get the stories to cities as quickly as possible, in the form of downloadable files, so city communications staff can use the stories when and where they want.



CITIES MEETINGS

CCX Media staff city meetings for our nine member cities, but also load agendas, index and timestamp each meeting for easy navigation, and schedule meetings to run on the Channel 16s.

In 2024, staff transitioned all cities to new Cablecast software and added closed captioning for meetings with each city's migration. Technical staff also assisted Robbinsdale in designing and installing new council equipment.
